### **MINUTES**

#### **1. Attendance**

#### **2. Projects Manager's proposal**

- Mr. Projects explained that the event would take the form of a talent show with a huge artist performance at the end on the 24 th of September. The theme would be: "All Roads Lead to Rhodes". There would be a callout period for artists around Rhodes University and the surrounding Makhanda area; the incentive being to perform in front of a big artist. He added that there were drama students who had prepared a play they requested to perform at the event.
- Mr. Projects explained that the event would be at the drama department. He noted that the funds leftover from O-week, R67 809.00, would be used for all activities for the event. If the funds were exhausted, then the hall entertainment budget may be utilized.
- Mr. Projects explained that they would charge a R30 entrance fee which would go towards the SRC Student Assistance fund.

- There was general consensus that Madam Treasurer-General would enquire with other artists on their availability by Friday. Should a cheaper artist not be available, Mr. Fellow would be booked for R50 000.
- Mr. Projects would enquire about the possible use of R7 000 from the Intervarsity budget.
- Mr. Projects explained that he had been approached by the Nkoli-Fassie Society to paint the library wall for pride month by Friday. There would be a pride celebration at Great Field on the 29 th of September. There was general consensus that the event activation would happen at the “All Roads Lead to Rhodes” event.

### **3. Enactus Society Request**

- Madam Treasurer-General explained that 7 Enactus members would be traveling to Johannesburg and had a budget of R15 000 which they had exhausted on accommodation. They requested assistance in the form of R5000 for transport and food. Madam secretary-General noted that the trip would not benefit the student body or incoming committee.
- There was general consensus that the Council could not assist.
